

What happens after a Sexual Misconduct report is made?

Every reported Complaint of alleged Sexual Misconduct will be investigated thoroughly, promptly and in a confidential matter. The campus Title IX Coordinator will be responsible for overseeing the prompt, fair, and impartial investigation and resolution of Complaints filed with New York Film Academy. The investigation and resolution processes will generally be completed 60 calendar days from the date the Title IX Coordinator was informed of the Complaint. Both the Complainant and Respondent will receive a Final Outcome Letter within 20 days from the conclusion of the hearing.

Anticipated Timeline after Reporting Sexual Misconduct:

1 to 3 days after Complaint is filed: Title IX's initial, individual meetings with both the Respondent and Complainant

Day 4 through 6: Investigator is appointed

Day 7 through 14: Formal investigation

Day 14 through 17: Investigation findings are shared with Senior

Administration

Day 17 through 24: Disciplinary Hearing

Day 25 through 35: Resolution Final Outcome Letter is sent

Day 38 through 48: Complaint and Respondent have 10 days to appeal

Day 36 through 38: Sanctions are enforced (if necessary and if an appeal has not been made)

Day 48 through 58: Appeal Process (if necessary)

The Complainant and the Respondent are entitled to the same opportunities to have others present during a campus disciplinary appeal proceeding and shall be informed of the outcome of any campus disciplinary proceeding alleging sexual assault.
